### **Mid-Michigan Health Plan opens enrollment**

Ithaca, Stanton, St. Johns- Enrollment is open for eligible Clinton, Gratiot and Montcalm county residents in the Mid-Michigan Health Plan (MMHP), which provides basic medically necessary and primary health care for the uninsured.

Mid-Michigan Health Plan membership is now open to residents with incomes below 150 percent of the federal poverty level (\$17,235 for a single person). The plan provides health care coverage of last resort to residents who don't qualify for Medicaid or Healthy Michigan, are exempt from obtaining insurance through the federal health exchange or did not purchase insurance through the exchange during open enrollment.
