Stanton- Mid-Michigan District Health Department (MMDHD) is looking for volunteers to participate in an emergency preparedness exercise. The exercise will be held on July 20, 2016 from 8:00 a.m. to noon at the Central Montcalm High School in Stanton.

The exercise will involve community partners and will test MMDHDs capability to respond to a large-scale public health emergency, such as an epidemic.

Volunteers will act as community members receiving “pretend” medication during an emergency. No experience or special skill is required to participate. All ages are welcome, but kids 16 years of age or younger must be accompanied by an adult. The facility is handicap accessible. Lunch will be provided.
