It is important to us that you can find affordable, quality care you can feel good about. That's why our family planning services are available to everyone. While the Mid-Michigan District Health Department (MMDHD) primarily serves Clinton, Gratiot and Montcalm counties, you do not need to be a resident of these counties to participate in the Family Planning Program! In fact, we have many women who travel a great distance outside of their own counties to be seen in our clinics.

Fees are based on a sliding scale (according to income) and payment is requested at the time of your visit. **However, no one is denied service due to inability to pay.**

Available Services

Birth Control/Education

Education is an important part in helping you make a choice about birth control. We will help you learn more about your body and help you select the method(s) of birth control that are right for you.

Methods that you can choose from are:

- Abstinence (no sex)
- Condoms
- Spermicide
- Vaginal Ring
- IUD/IUS
- Nexplanon (implant)
- Depo-Provera (shot)
- Birth Control Pills
- Natural Family Planning
- Emergency Contraception
- Other options may be available

Pregnancy Testing

Pregnancy testing results, as with all other family planning information, are highly confidential and will only be given to you in person.

Sexually Transmitted Infection Testing

Male and female testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections is also available. HIV testing is available and can be confidential or anonymous.

Exams

First time and yearly exams are provided by the nurse practitioner with an appointment.

Referrals

Referrals can be made for additional services as needed.
